Note: The map includes those facilities that offer separate degree programmes or training in jazz, rock or pop. Exceptions or special cases are indicated in footnotes. Institutions that only offer isolated modules in these areas are excluded, as are music schools and facilities of advanced or continuing education. Also excluded are institutions with an emphasis on musicals or film music and those for part-time church musicians with a focus on popular music. Facilities with more than one site are marked at the location of their headquarters. If the headquarters do not have an emphasis on pop, rock or jazz, the map indicates only the site that features such an emphasis.
