Note: The map indicates in particular those facilities organised in the Church Music Directors' Conference of the Evangelical Church in Germany and in the Conference of Heads of Training Centres for Catholic Church Music in Germany, provided that they offer at least C-level certification. In addition to the institutions shown here, the Evangelical Church also offers C-level certification at several of its state churches, including training supervised by state church music directors. Similarly, the offices and departments of church music in the Catholic Church also offer C-level certification, sometimes under the auspices of district or regional church music directors.

- 1 The former bachelor's programme in church music has been discontinued. The Arp Schnitger Master's Degree in Historical Church Music was initiated in WS 2017-18.
- 2 Church music is also offered as a double subject in the degree programme for music education.
- 3 Church music as part of an education degree, either with a double subject in music and music at grammar schools (Gymnasien), or music at primary schools with additional C-level certification in church music. Both degree programmes are offered in cooperation with Dresden University of Church Music.
- 4 Combined programme with bachelor's degree in church music and music teaching at grammar schools, in cooperation with the Evangelical University of Church Music in Halle.
- 5 Parallel degree programme in music teaching and church music, in cooperation with the University of Church Music of the Evangelical State Church in Baden.
